## **NEWS FROM THE OFFICE**

#### **Excursions**

Due to our new finance system, we now have to enforce any payment cut off dates for payments for excursions and performances. In the past we have quite often taken payments after the due date but unfortunately this will **no longer** be able to occur. From now on the cut-off date will have to be adhered to and we will no longer take payments past the due date. If a payment cannot be made due to financial circumstances please contact the office **prior** to when the payment is due and we will endeavour to make a payment plan.

#### **Payment Envelope Box**

We have reintroduced the payment envelope box on the wall near the office window. Any payments can be placed in a sealed envelope inside this box. Envelopes are located on the desk diagonally opposite the office. Please make sure all details are completed, including first and last name, child's class and what the payment is for.

#### **POP Payments**

Parent Online Payments can be made by going on to the school website and looking for the tab 'Make a payment'. There are only a few mandatory fields that need to be completed; these are marked with an asterisk. This is our preferred payment method however cash and EFTPOS are of course still accepted at the school office between 9am and 3pm.

#### **Telephone Calls and Messages to Staff and Students**

School phones are attended from 8:30am to 3:30pm on school days.

**Staff messages:** Routine matters with teaching staff are best dealt with by notes which should always be signed and dated. More involved matters are best discussed face-to-face with teachers and appointments can be made by phoning the school office.

Urgent brief messages can be relayed to staff via the office however, teaching staff will not be available to come to the phone during normal lesson times. Please note that the Principal will always be available to discuss any matters of urgency, that are personal, confidential or of a worrying nature.

**Student messages:** It is requested that telephone messages for students be of an *urgent* nature only. *Urgent* brief messages may be telephoned to the school office and staff will relay them to the teacher or the child concerned. Messages should be received by 2:30pm to allow time for the message to be delivered to the classroom.

Arrangements for how students are getting home each day should be conveyed to the child in the morning before school. For urgent unplanned changes, please call the office prior to 2:30pm where possible, and the message will be relayed to your child.

#### **Change of Addresses and Telephone Numbers**

Please notify the school in writing of any changes to home addresses or telephone numbers. Please include mobile phone numbers and two emergency contact people. It is vital that the school records are kept up to date to ensure that parents can be contacted quickly in times of emergency. Forms are available from the school office.
