#### NAIDOC Week

Last week at GEPS, our staff and students participated in various indigenous-inspired activities during NAIDOC Week. The theme was '*Always Was, Always Will Be'*. Usually celebrations occur in July but due to COVID 19, these events had to be postponed to the week starting 8<sup>th</sup> November. To celebrate, students wore colours and read books that reflect the indigenous culture and participated in learning activities and games that recognised Aboriginal traditions. Thank you to Mrs Coles for helping teachers organise these activities.

#### Kindergarten 2021

Our new Kindergarten students for 2021 are half way through their orientation program and we have enjoyed getting to know them. It was so lovely to wander into the Kindergarten classrooms and see how settled and excited they are to be starting school. We are very much looking forward to them joining us next year.

#### **End of Year Activities**

#### Dear Parents

We want to offer families more flexibility with their work commitments and child care arrangements and to create more opportunities across the whole community. Having Out of School Hours Care available at local schools is a great way to achieve this.

As part of the NSW Government's \$120 million Before and After School Care (BASC) commitment, parents at all NSW schools were recently invited to complete a Have Your Say survey. The survey results have helped us to better understand the needs of families and what's important to them.


News from Pebbles Snack Cave.
