Happy Week 8, Gosford East families and community!

ATTENDANCE

Congratulations to all our students who are at school, every day, on time. Thank you to our parents and carers for continuing to provide reasons for why their children are away. I had some happy parents come and tell me how lovely it was to receive their 100% attendance letters.

I also had a few parents confused as they didn't think holiday leave days were counted as part of the absence percentage, but they do. There is an intensive focus, state-wide, to have students come to school every day during the term. The department asks parents to take their family holidays in school holiday time.

- Our overall school attendance rate is 92.3%
- ·
 *★*188 students have school attendance of 95-100%
 ★
- .27 students have school attendance of 85-90% (risk of disengagement and learning and social difficulties)
- •49 students have school attendance below 85% of the time (high risk of disengagement and learning and social difficulties).

When it comes to attending school, every day matters. If your child misses as little as 1 day per fortnight, they will miss 4 weeks of school per year, which adds up to over 1 year missed over their school life.





ATTENDANCE

Education for your child is important and regular attendance at school is essential for your child to achieve their educational best and increase their career and life options. NSW public schools work in partnership with parents encourage and to support regular attendance of children and young people. When your child attends school every day, learning becomes easier and vour child will build and maintain friendships with other children.



Parents and caregivers must ensure:

• Their children of compulsory school age are enrolled in a government or registered non-government school or, they are registered with the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) for Home Schooling.

• Their children who are enrolled at school attend every day the school is open for their instruction.

• They provide an explanation for absences by means such as a telephone call, written note, text message or email to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence.

• They work in partnership with the school to plan and implement strategies to support regular attendance at school, including communicating with the school if they are aware of issues impacting on their child's attendance or engagement with school.
